

Award categories



- PhD Thesis Award for exceptional contribution to developments in the field of gaseous detectors
 - PhD completed within 2 years at the time of the closing of the call (thesis must have been defended already)

- Early Career Scientist Award for outstanding scientific developments in the field of gaseous detectors
 - = 7 years (excluding demonstrated career interruptions) after PhD at the time of the closing of the call

- Exceptional Contributions to the DRD1 Collaboration Award
 - Solution Named by the Awards Committee and not by candidacy
 - Solution Note: No constraint on career stage



Nominations are open!



- The candidate can be nominated by a Member of the collaboration (or by her/his thesis Advisor(s) in case of the PhD Theses Awards)
 - ©Candidacies must be accompanied by a support letter (not necessarily from DRD1 Members) explaining the nominee's qualifications and scientific achievements and motivating the proposed award with a short text.
- ©Candidacies can be proposed until 1st December, award given during the first 2026 DRD1 collaboration meeting
- Exceptional Contributions to the DRD1 Collaboration Award by Committee choice and not nomination
